**Candidate Flow**

Each candidate will be on stage for 45 minutes with the students and the moderator.

- Moderator introduces candidate - 1 minute
- Candidate presents his/her climate/energy plan - 10 minutes
- 3 students seated on stage will introduce themselves and ask 2 questions each - approx. 5 minutes for each question and answer
- Moderator thanks the students and candidate - 1 minute

The candidate will walk off stage, down to the main floor, turning right in front of the stage where s/he can shake hands and then turn left to head out through the lobby - 5-10 minutes in the auditorium.

There will not be questions from the audience.
